TRAINING AGREEMENT

Coshocton City Schools will be conducting several classes over the course of the 2018-2019 school year. The course cost is \$250.00, and a down payment of \$150.00 must be paid by the first class date, unless arrangements are made, with the remainder to be paid by the last in-classroom session. An applicant can make arrangement for payment by talking with the training manager. All returned checks would be charged a \$35.00 fee. Coshocton City Schools will provide the student with 24 hours of classroom instruction and 8 hours of practical driving instruction based on the Ohio Driver Training Curriculum. The 8 hours of hands-on driving is generally broken down into five driving sessions. The State of Ohio regulations require Coshocton City Schools to make available all training within 180 days from the beginning of the class. Coshocton City Schools reserves the right to cancel this agreement at any time, should the student's conduct indicate a lack of responsibility deemed necessary by Coshocton City Schools to safely operate a motor vehicle. If a student is tardy to class, Coshocton City Schools reserves the right to deny the student admittance to that class. Destruction of property, the possession, distribution, or use of any tobacco product, alcohol or drug of abuse is strictly prohibited. Should this agreement be cancelled under such circumstances, the Coshocton City Schools will offer a pro rated refund after the first class has taken place.

A student may begin classroom instruction at age 15 years and 5 months. However, a student is required to obtain a valid temporary permit and pay tuition in full, prior to the scheduling of the behind the wheel-driving phase of the training. A fee of \$15.00 may be charged should a student fail to appear for a behind-the-wheel session without a twenty-four hours notice. If a behind the wheel driving time is missed, it is the responsibility of the student to contact the instructor. Student will be picked up and dropped off at Coshocton High School unless other arrangements are made by the instructor. Coshocton City Schools will loan the student a textbook for use during class. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for any book not returned or returned damaged. The use of the school vehicle will not be permitted for the driving test. Driving will be done in Coshocton, Knox, Licking, Tuscarawas, Guernsey, Muskingum and Holmes counties.

The driving school will furnish a licensed instructor, insurance and a motor vehicle for all instruction. The driving school **does not** guarantee the issuance of a state driver's license to the student. All instruction will be completed within 6 months from the class starting date. No extension will be given without a valid written request, filed and accepted by Coshocton City Schools. The student and the parent/guardian will be jointly liable for this agreement in the full amount even if the course is not completed.

A student must complete all classroom work before the final exam can be taken. A score of **75%** is needed on the final to pass the classroom work. Should a student fail to achieve the minimum score, an opportunity will be given for the student to re-take the exam (additional classroom attendance may be needed). A student who misses a class will have the opportunity to make up that work during the next classroom session or at a scheduled time worked out between the parents and the school official. A certificate of completion will be

furnished to all students (within 5 business days) upon successful completion of all course work and the return of the evaluation form for the behind the wheel driving phase of the course.
