Include things such as what elements do you enjoy being around (bond with) what are some compounds you might end up in due to bonding and what elements you don't necessarily like to be around (bond with).

List some of your physical properties and how they affect your behavior and how they affect how you might be used. Do the same with physical properties.

List your history of the past 500 years or so. How have you spent your life in the last 500 or so years?

Why are you important to humans? Or maybe you aren't and if you aren't, why not.

Use your imagination, but the facts you present must be correct. In other words, use facts to write what obviously is a fictional account of an element.
