OHIO STANDARDS FOR THE TEACHING PROFESSION

Beginning with next year, OTES will require teachers to write 2 SMART goals based on the Ohio Standards for the Teaching Profession. The standards are listed below. If you did not pick up the book, Standards for Ohio Educators, at our last in-service, copies are available. Email Jami Brown and she will put one in the interoffice mail to you. Remember, all teachers will be evaluated next year. Get a head start and become familiar with the standards!

Standard 1—Students

Teachers understand student learning and development and respect the diversity of the students they teach.

Standard 2—Content

Teachers know and understand the content area for which they have instructional responsibility.

Standard 3—Assessment

Teachers understand and use varied assessments to inform instruction, evaluate and ensure student learning.

Standard 4—Instruction

Teachers plan and deliver effective instruction that advances the learning of each individual student

Standard 5—Learning Environment

Teachers create learning environments that promote high levels of learning and achievement for all students.

Standard 6—Collaboration and Communication

Teachers collaborate and communicate with students, parents, other educators, administrators and the community to support student learning.

Standard 7 Professional Responsibility and Growth

Effective teachers understand that professional development is a continuous process for which they are responsible.
